
Facilitate, further strenghten the LSH ecosystem

Lessons Learned



- Companies in the lead: they determine the priorities and the needs
- Involve the management of the members: their buy-in is crucial
- Execution of projects only successful with participation of members
- Invest in relationships with municipalities and provinces: their financial support can kick-start initiatives
- One and easy to access "bill board": the Managing Director
- Hands-on board members
- Informal events are important for networking, but also expertise sharing (BBQ, drinks, congresses)
- Portals facilitate expertise sharing: from experienced entrepeneur to start-up


